WHEREAS

When developing a representative government with separation of power between branches, it is imperative for each branch to be able to check the power of the others; and,

WHEREAS

The Legislative branch has been running in parallel with the Executive branch for far too long without reasonable checks in place; and,

WHEREAS

Reviewing the usage of the ASCSU Student Fee throughout the year will promote stability and responsible use of the ASCSU Student Fee; and,

WHEREAS

Section 708 of Article VII of the Associated Students of Colorado State University Constitution states that:

“No legislation related to elections shall be voted upon or brought to the Senate the week prior to Spring Break or during the election period.”; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That Section 703 of Article VII of the Constitution of the Associated Students of Colorado State University be amended to read as follows:

“Section 703: Insert Section 703 here”

That Article VIII of the Constitution of the Associated Students of Colorado State University be amended to read as follows:
“Insert Article 8 here”
