WHEREAS: Students in attendance at Colorado State University have no formal or universal

absence policy to reference in case of illness, emergency, or binding outside

obligation.

WHEREAS: To establish a campus wide absence policy that would permit any student be

absent for two days per semester that are excused by the university.

WHEREAS: These absences would last the entirety of the day in which they were enacted, and

require no official documentation to be permissible.

WHEREAS: These absences could not be used to excuse students from activities on days in

which a previously established assignment, exam, or other 'for credit' activity had been stated within the syllabus or other form of communication from a professor. In these cases, current policy of professor contact and express permission would be

required and would fall under no rules stated here within.

WHEREAS: These absences would not excuse students from on campus jobs or other

extracurricular duties.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That all fulltime students be given two days per semester in which they could not be penalized for unknown course content and the activities that take place on these days.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That all documentation of these two days be managed through 'Ramweb' and enacted on the day of necessity through an online form prior to 9:00 a.m. day of.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That the creation of such a policy fall equally under the duties of the Executive Director of University Affairs of the Forty-Third Senate and executive administration no later than the dawn of the third Summer class session of 2014, to be enacted for the academic year of 2014-2015.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That the Forty-Third Senate of the Associated Students of Colorado State University officially endorses the creation of the excused absence policy.
